DO HEREBY RESOLVE, WHEREAS, Yellow Quill First Nation:			
1.	has experienced problems of vandalism due to unsupervised activities of minors within the community during all hours of the day and night;		
2.	believes that the welfare and safety of all Yellow Quill First Nation children should become a priority for their health, well-being, education and particularly for the prevention and avoidance of crime including theft, vandalism and general mischief;		
3.	is concerned for the avoidance and prevention of disorderly conduct and all matters ancillary thereto including the observance of law and order and providing for penalties for the violation thereof on Yellow Quill First Nation lands by its membership and those unauthorized persons who may be on Yellow Quill First Nation lands; and		
4.	Chief and Council deem in the best interests of Yellow Quill First Nation to make a By-law for the observance of law and order pursuant to their power and authority as recognized in s. 85(1) of the <i>Indian Act</i> of Canada.		
NOW THEREFORE, the Government of Yellow Quill First Nation through its Chief and Council do hereby decide and resolve as follows:			
1.	The Yellow Quill First Nation Curfew By-law attached to this Band Council Resolution is hereby approved and enacted;		
2.	That the Yellow Quill First Nation Curfew By-law be filed immediately with the Ministry of Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada; and		
3.	3. The Yellow Quill First Nation Curfew By-law be forwarded to the Commanding Officer of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police for the Detachment of Kelvington – Rose Valley, Saskatchewan with an accompanying request for immediate enforcement.
