Kaydance & Santana Pauchay Scholarships

What are the scholarships?

Yellow Quill Holdings ("Holdings") have established two scholarships valued at \$2000 each to encourage Yellow Quill band members (18+) residing on or off-reserve to continue to pursue Post-secondary education.

- Kaydance Pauchay Scholarship will be awarded to a student enrolled in University.
- Santana Pauchay Scholarship will be awarded to a student enrolled in Technical/Trade School.

These two scholarships will be awarded at the end of the respective Fall/Winter semester in any given school year. The scholarships are contingent upon recipients participating in second year full-time studies, and are payable only when the recipient is in actual attendance. **FIRST YEAR STUDENTS ARE INELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIPS.** Scholarships are non-transferrable, and cannot be deferred.

Eligibility

Open to all current Yellow Quill Post-Secondary students who are enrolled in the second year (or higher) full-time studies at a recognized Post-secondary educational institution or technical school. The student must:

- Be Yellow Quill Band Member living on or off-reserve (must provide proof of Status Card)
- Complete Application Form

Applicants may re-qualify each year if all eligibility criteria are met; however, applications MUST be re-submitted every year. Students awarded a scholarship by Holdings will be ineligible to reapply for at least one academic year. Also, a scholarship can only be awarded twice to the same student for a given program of study.

Loss of Eligibility: If recipient does not remain as a full-time student, or who does not fulfill the eligibility criteria and is thus unable to receive their scholarship, the scholarship will be awarded to the next runner up.

Application Requirements

- 1. Applicants must complete a written summary of 500 words or less, indicating:
 - a. Applicant Background
 - b. Reasoning as to why scholarship should be awarded to them
 - c. How funds will be used on the basis of need.
- 2. Applicants must submit recent transcripts for the applicable Fall/Winter semester as part of their completed scholarship application to Holdings.
- 3. All applications must be received no later than four weeks following the end of the respective fall/Winter semester in any given school year.
- 4. Recipients will be required to sign a Declaration of Compliance and release of Liability. This will include the recipient's consent to the use of their name and photograph, without further compensation, in any publicity carried out by Holdings relative to this scholarship.
- 6. Applicants agree to abide by all decisions of Holdings, which are final and without appeal in all matters pertaining to the Scholarships. Holdings has final and binding discretion to decide all questions respecting the awarding of scholarships, its administration and its decisions.
- 7. All application information must be found by, the Board, to be true, accurate, and complete.

Applications are available at the Yellow Quill Urban Office, Yellow Quill Band Office, Yellow Quill Post-Secondary Office or Yellow Quill Holdings Inc.

Holdings Board of Directors will review and screen all Application submissions for selection. Scholarship recipients will be notified by the Board. A notification email will be sent to all applicants that were not selected for a scholarship. Holdings Board of Directors has the discretion to award 2 of Kaydance Pauchay Scholarship or 2 of Santana Pauchay Scholarship if interest for either is not received for any given semester.
